



215.1. General

The IAC Legal Counsel is responsible for providing advice on day-to-day matters and, in addition, may be requested to be present at Board of Directors meetings to advise the Board. Detailed legal work that involves courtroom activity, tax matters, and other business that requires considerable time will be hired out. This is usually coordinated through the EAA's legal counsel.

215.2. Program Administration

The IAC Legal Counsel may be an appointed member (Class IV) of the IAC Board of Directors. The position is an attorney who is an IAC member and is available to do limited legal work for IAC on a *pro bono* basis.
